The simple answer is nitrates. If you fertilize your lawn, it already has elevated levels of nitrates, so adding even a little more can kill your grass. Dog urine contains a variety of nitrogen compounds that kill grass. Please be a kind neighbor and do not ruin other people's lawns.

If an accident occurs be sure you have a bag and glove to clean up the mess. Thank you.

FISH SPECIES

What fish can be found in our catch and release pond? Both trout and bass are present in the waters. If you choose to feed them, please only feed specific foods designed for these species.

NUTRIA

Also known as swamp rats - many ponds, lakes, and waterways in Oregon are troubled by this non-native, invasive species. On occasion, they have been spotted in our area and especially at the pond the city owns south of the community. Be sure to let Lee and Rosi know if any are sighted. They ruin beaches, wipe out native habitat and can be aggressive. Your safety is critically important.

SPORT COURT

Sport Court, but not motocross! Sport Court of Oregon installed the court with a special outdoor decking that is great for such sports as basketball, badminton, and other such sports. It is not good for bikes and scooters which are hard on the decking, so please ride elsewhere in the community.

Picnic Table Improvements - The picnic tables have had some much-needed maintenance and will be ready for you to enjoy warm evenings on the pond once spring rolls around.


